A is for ABBAYE DE CRÉTEIL In 1906 a group of French writers, artists, and composers established the Abbaye de Créteil at a villa in

Creteils south-east of Paris.

The group was partly inspired by the French Renaissance writer François Rabelais, who had written about a self-supporting commune in a monastery called the Abbaye de Thelema. It had championed group labor and intellectual self-improvement.

The Abbaye de Créteil community lasted only two years – ending in February of 1908.
