Art Term Corner

BIOMORPHIC forms or images are ones that while abstract nevertheless refer to, or evoke, living forms such as plants and the human body it comes from combining the Greek words 'bios', meaning life, and 'morphe', meaning form.

The term seems to have come into use around the 1930s to describe the imagery in the more abstract types of surrealist painting and sculpt ure particularly in the work of Joan Miró and Jean Arp (see automatism). Henry Moore and Barbara Hepworth also produced some

superb biomorphs at that time, and later so did <u>Louise</u> Bourgeois.

You MUST use white and three colors of your own choosing; a total of 4 colors. No more and no less. If your work is chosen for the show you will be asked to provide small color swatches of your three colors that will be displayed alongside your work. -2D painting and drawing work only. No Sculpture. No Photography. No crafts.

-Must have been produced during the 2020-2021 calendar year.
